National Medical Commission

The Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic informs that the School of Medicine of Adam University has been working since 2017 for training local and international students on the basis of national licenses for the promotion of quality medical education and providing medical services.

In accordance with international requirements in the educational field, Adam University has been successfully accredited by the International Accreditation Agency for Accreditation and Rating (IAAR) according to the standards of the World Federation for Medical Education.

Adam University is completely fulfilling all the requirements set by the National Medical Commission from 18.11.2021.

- a) (i) In accordance with the requirements of the State Educational Standard of Higher Professional Education of the Kyrgyz Republic (equal to MBBS qualification in India) is 6 years (360 ECTS).
- (ii) The practical trainings are at least 85 ECTS, including an internship during the 6th final year (semesters 11-12).

The School of Medicine of Adam University provides the same clinical environment for all medical students for their clinical internships, regardless of their nationality or citizenship.

- (iii) The training is conducted in English. At the same time, the curriculum includes compulsory study of kyrgyz or russian languages, which is necessary for communication with patients during practicals/internships in clinics.
- (iv) The curriculum includes all disciplines in accordance with the requirements of the National Medical Commission (NMC).

b) After graduation School of Medicine, all students of Adam University receive a state diploma and European Diploma Supplement, which gives them the right to obtain a license to practice medicine and, regardless of citizenship, and also have the right to work in the Kyrgyz Republic.

c) The requirements for qualifying examinations are developed in accordance with the standards of the World Federation for Medical Education and are based on the Objective Structured Clinical Examination methodology

(OSCE).

d) At the final year, the curriculum includes an additional module on preparation for professional exams FMGE (Foreign Medical Graduate Examination).
